

## Instruction for Submission to Journal of JSPRS

1. The primary authors of all submitted papers must be members of the Society. This requirement does not apply to submissions solicited by the Society.

2. A “original paper” is a report on original and useful research done by the author, whose results have not been previously announced. A “technical report” is a report on a useful study or other work conducted by the author. A “research bulletin” is a current update on original and useful research done by the author, whose results have not been previously announced. An “commentary” is a report that relates useful information and provides an enlightening explanation of new knowledge. An “information room” is a simple notice about useful technical information. A “camera eye” is an image or series of images of new and topical interest to readers, accompanied by simple descriptions.

3. The number of pages of the paper (in final printed form including drawings, tables and photos) and the fees payable for each are as listed below. If the co-authors of an original paper, technical report or research bulletin are not members of the Society, an additional fee of ¥5,000 per person is payable.

4. Costs for printing of color pages are borne by the authors. Costs are as follows:

(1) ¥60,000 per color page printed

(2) If two or more color pages appear in a single paper, the charge for the second and subsequent pages is ¥40,000 per color page.

5. Please submit four copies in the case of theses, or three copies in the case of technical reports, analyses and research bulletins, on A4-size paper. Only one copy is required for other types of submissions. Be sure to number the pages.

6. The paper must conform to the “guidelines for authors” described separately.

7. To submit your paper, download the submission form (a Microsoft Word document) from the Society’s website (<http://jsprs.iis.u-tokyo.ac.jp>) and fill in the required information. Please submit this form both as data on a diskette and as a printout on A4-size paper, together with your paper.

9. The Society will issue a receipt for your paper within 10 days of its arrival at the Society’s Executive Office. If you do not receive your receipt within 14 days of sending in your submission, please contact the Executive Office.

10. All submitted papers will be published in Journal of the Japan Society of Photogrammetry and Remote Sensing, subject to deliberation by the Editorial Committee. The Editorial Committee will re-examine any papers submitted by reviewers and the Editorial Committee for review or revision and resubmission by the author if necessary. The Editorial Committee shall decide at its sole discretion in which issue each paper shall appear.

11. Once the Editorial Committee decides to publish the author’s paper, please submit the paper to the Society’s Executive Committee on CD-R or diskette.

12. The authors of all published papers retain the copyrights to said papers. However, exercise of said copyright shall be at the discretion of the Society.

13. If separate printing is required, the author is required to indicate the number of copies required in the appropriate column in the submission form. Separate fees are payable.
